1.0 Aeronautical Fees

1.1 Aircraft Landing Fees

Table 1 – Aircraft Landing Fees

- a) Aircraft Landing Fees apply to each landing of an aircraft with a corporate or commercial registration type at the Airport based on the maximum certified take-off weight (MTOW) of the aircraft.
- b) The fee charged for each landing will be based on Table 1.
- c) The Aircraft Landing fee is not applicable to:
 - i) The landing of an aircraft owned by the Air Cadet League of Canada;
 - ii) The landing of an aircraft in distress when the Airport was not the intended destination of the aircraft;
 - iii) The landing of an aircraft participating in an active search and rescue operation, and;
 - iv) The landing of an aircraft being operated as a flying training flight when:
 1. arrangements have been made in advance with the Airport Authority, and;
 2. the flight is being operated exclusively for the purpose of improving the skill and knowledge of student pilots or for flight testing of the aircraft itself.

1.2 Airport Terminal Fees

Table 2 – Airport Terminal Fees

- a) Airport Terminal Fees are based on the passenger seating capacity of the aircraft with a corporate or commercial registration type and apply to each landing of an aircraft at the Airport when the Air Terminal Building (ATB) is used for the embarking or disembarking of passengers.
- b) The Airport Terminal Fee does not apply when passengers do not disembark from the aircraft.
- c) The Airport Terminal Fee does not apply to fuel stops.
- d) The Airport Terminal Fee does not apply to aircraft operating medevac services.

Table 3 – Aircraft Parking Fees

- a) Applicable to all aircraft for the parking of that aircraft on an apron area or designated aircraft parking area and is based on the MTOW of the aircraft.
- b) Aircraft parking fees do not apply to an aircraft that is:
 - i) Parked for six (6) hours or less;
 - ii) Parked on land that is leased to a tenant of the Authority, or;
 - iii) Aircraft owned by the Air Cadet League of Canada

2.0 Non-Aeronautical Fees

2.1 Vehicle Parking

a) Tenant

For the provision of vehicle parking, the following rates are payable by the vehicle users, airport tenants or other companies. In the case of employee spaces, NNBA will bill employers.

b) Passenger

Passenger parking is available for \$5/day or \$20/week

2.2 Terminal Area Rentals

a) Square footage rates

General Office Space - \$10 per square foot per month (lunchroom, locker space, staff washroom, IT room)

Ticket Counter Space - \$200/annum/booth

b) Locker spaces

For the provision of locker space, the following rate is payable by the locker users, airport tenants or other companies. In the case of employee spaces, NNBA will bill employers.

\$20/locker/year

3.0 Airport Security

3.1 Keys/FOBS

The following charges will apply for the processing and issuance of keys/FOBS. Tenants or companies requiring access to the airport will be responsible for keys/FOBS issued to them or their employees

This document sets out the aeronautical and non-aeronautical rates and charges, as established by the Northern New Brunswick Airport Authority (NNBAA) for the Bathurst Regional Airport (or Airport). The Harmonized Sales Tax (HST) applies to and is in addition to the amounts listed in this document.

All fees listed in this document are in Canadian (CDN) dollars and are, unless otherwise noted, effective as at April 1, 2019.

² A 30% discount will apply to any Air Cadet League of Canada-related activity.
